
Dear Praying Friends,

My family and I have safely arrived in the States. My wife and our girls came in two months earlier for my wife's immigration purposes. My son and I arrived last month. I praise the Lord for keeping us safe and for allowing us to be united again as a family. My wife will start homeschooling Rachel and Daniel soon. Rachel will be in 3rd grade, and Daniel will be in 1st grade this year. Amanda, our little bundle of joy, is growing like a weed. She is 7 months old already. How time flies!

Our male staff, Bro. Emmanuel, is overseeing Landmark Baptist Church while we're here on furlough. The church is doing well. One of our church members, Ronald Hornilla whom I believe I mentioned in my last prayer letter, has been getting more involved in the church. He and his wife have been going soul winning and visiting on Saturdays. Before I left for the States, I did a Bible study on the right kind of music. As it is all over the world, the Filipino's hardest thing to give up is the wrong kind of music. One of the parents in our church had so many problems with their oldest son Martin who is college-aged. He was one of those who was physically present but absent in mind. I've watched Martin in church, and I've always thought of him as a good kid who was just all tangled up with the world. As a result of this Bible study on music, Martin, who used to sit at the back and could care less about preaching, turned out to be the one who sits on the front row now and says "AMEN" during the preaching and has been very faithful in soul winning. He even got up early Sunday morning to pick up one of his converts. He and his Dad got rid of the bad music they had in their cell phones and had me download godly music instead. Another teen boy named Hero gave up his bad music CDs, and I had him break them in front of the church with a hammer. Doesn't that make you want to get excited and shout "AMEN! PRAISE THE LORD!"

We are back on furlough for a couple reasons. One, of course, is to visit family. But the main reason is to raise additional support, as I am planning to start a Bible college in June of next year. The last reason we came back is to raise some funds for property. We have been looking at some vacant property that is near where we are right now. It would cost roughly \$20,000 for 250 square meters and then, of course, the added cost of building a building on that property. I figured we could build up since property is extremely expensive where we are.
